Use the <u>school locator</u> tool to find schools designated as the home school in your area; <u>Create a parent account</u> or log in to your existing account;

- 1. Add a student to the account;
- 2. Add additional students for other grades to the account now, if you have them.

Your child must meet the following age requirements to enter Kindergarten:

• To register for Junior Kindergarten, your child must be 4 years old by December 31 in the current year

To register for Senior Kindergarten, your child must be 5 years old by December 31 in the current year

Registration is open for grades 1 to 8.
